My main research interests are in the broad areas of human memory and cognitive aging and include:

Memory and aging, memory in school-aged children, formal models of memory, multinomial processing tree models, episodic memory, source and context memory, familiarity and recollection, false memory, prospective memory, interplay of semantic and episodic memory, memory and psychopathology, memory and judgment bias, hindsight bias, misinformation effect, judgment and decision making in older adults, executive function across the life-span.
